
WHAT IMPACTS THE AUTOGRADE™ VEHICLE SCALE?

AutoGrade™ Vehicle Scale takes into consideration the collective existing and repaired damages captured in the condition report when determining the grade.



MAJOR GRADE REDUCTIONS

Hail Damage*
Poor Previous Repairs - Body
Body Damage/Panel
replacement *
No Keys Present/NonDrivable
Structural Damage
Mechanical /Engine Damages
Fire - Flood - Biohazards

MODERATE GRADE REDUCTIONS

Glass / Windshield*
Wheel Damage*
Body Damage /Repair*
Tire Replacement Required*
(3/32nd or less tread depth)+
Interior Damages*
Damaged / Missing Parts*

MINOR GRADE REDUCTIONS

Body Damage / Cosmetic* Tire Wear* (4/32nd - 7/32nd) Acceptable Previous Repairs

*Damage Size / Severity /Number of Occurrences per damage line item may have a graduated impact on total grade.

+ Tire tread depth is NOT used to calculate the grade unless a tire(s) is marked with 3/32 or less tread depth and has no associated tire replacement damage on the respective tire. In other words, AutoGrade™ does not use both tread depth AND the tire damage line item to calculate the grade, ensuring there is no "double dipping" for tire replacement.
